

- JIRA
 - "Track anything issues, bugs, tasks, deadlines, code, hours – to stay on top of every team's activity."
 - Commercial system
- Provide mobile access for iPhone / iPad
 - Workflow-Management









- Server
 - REST endpoint provided by JIRA
 - JSON used for representation
- Client
 - iPad, iPhone
 - Contains some business logic
 - Using SBJson XOR JSONKit for object translation
 - ASIHTTPRequest to map Cocoa network functionality



- Feature Support
- Adaption of User Interface
 - Varying functionality depending on the device running
- Network traffic & security
 - Big JSON-responses easily possible → Compression
 - SSL connection and Basic Authentication
- Agile Workflow Management
- Comply with Apple's UI and AppStore Guidelines



- Separation of Concerns
 - Backend (REST, JSON, ...)
 - Frontend (iPhone / iPad controlling)
- 2nd meeting: Prototype with full reading and viewing capabilities
- Turn of the year: full CRUD support
- Final Meeting: beta testing, bug fixing, refinement
